

II. Pleadings and Motions

1. Defendants are not required to serve on other Defendants copies of pleadings or motions unless: (a) ordered by the Court; or (b) such pleading or motion specifically applies to another Defendant or mentions another Defendant.

III. Copies

1. Copies of docket sheets must be obtained via PACER. PACER may be accessed through the Court's website at (<http://www.tnmd.uscourts.gov/>) under "Case Information" and then "Docket Sheets."

2. Copies of documents filed with the Court must be obtained from the party who filed the document initially, rather than from the Court, absent extraordinary circumstances.

IV. Trial and Pretrial Conference

By Order entered contemporaneously herewith, this case is set for a jury trial on November 4, 2002 and a pre-trial conference on October 14, 2002. The parties should not anticipate a continuance of the trial date.

V. Dispositive Motions

The following deadlines are established for dispositive motions:

1. Dispositive motion deadline is June 4, 2002.
2. Responses shall be filed by July 1, 2002.
3. Replies shall be filed by July 15, 2002.

The parties should not anticipate a continuance of the dispositive motion deadlines.

VI. Referral to Magistrate Judge

This case is referred to the Magistrate Judge for the entry of a scheduling order and determination of all non-dispositive motions. All pre-trial deadlines shall conform to the trial, pre-trial conference, and dispositive motion deadlines set forth above. Absent order of the Magistrate Judge, this case is not subject to customized case management pursuant to Local Rule 11.

Pursuant to Local Rule 11(e)(1) and Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(d), discovery is not stayed absent further order of the District Judge.

VII. Summons

Plaintiffs are hereby ordered to file by Monday, May 14, 2001, all summons to be issued by the Court regarding the Complaint. Such summons shall be served promptly by Plaintiffs on Defendants to avoid delay in the progression of the case.

Counsel for Plaintiffs shall promptly serve a copy of this Order on Defendants with the Complaint.
