


with each other before burdening the Court with additional motions which should be resolved in the first case by the lawyers talking to each other. If the lawyers are unable to communicate with each other effectively, the Magistrate Judge can always set the matter for hearings in Court.

The Clerk is directed to serve this Order on (1) the parties that are bringing or opposing the subject motion ruled upon; and (2) as provided in the Order (Docket Entry No. 2) entered May 8, 2001.

It is so ORDERED.
