ORDER


On December 18, 1990, this Court adopted Administrative Order 124 (copy attached), requiring that all proposed orders related to acceptance and investment of registry funds by the Clerk submitted after December 1, 1990, include the following language:


"The Clerk is directed to deduct a registry fee from the interest earned on this investment account in an amount equal to ten (10) percent of the interest earned."


For the convenience of the Court and of counsel, the previous Administrative Order is amended. From the date of this Order forward, the stated language shall no longer be required and the Clerk of this Court is hereby authorized and directed to collect a fee of ten (10) percent of interest earned on all invested registry funds. The collection of said fee shall be made upon distribution of funds held in the registry as ordered by the Court.



O R D E R

Pursuant to 55 Fed. Reg. 42,867 (Oct. 24, 1990), it is hereby ordered that all proposed orders submitted after December 1, 1990, for investment of funds by the Clerk include therein language in substantially the same form as the following:

The Clerk is directed to deduct a registry fee from the from the interest earned on this investment account in an amount equal to ten (10) percent of the interest earned.

Funds tendered to the Court for investment by the Clerk prior to December 1, 1990, will be governed by the provisions of 54 Fed. Reg. 20,497 (May 11, 1989), which prescribed that the Clerk deduct a registry fee in the amount equivalent to the first forty-five (45) days of interest earned.
