ORDER


The United States Attorney for the Middle District of Tennessee has requested by letter dated January 9, 2019, that the Court extend the terms of Administrative Order No. 82-Supplemental entered on December 21, 2018, which suspended until January 11, 2019, all civil litigation in which the United States of America is a party, its agencies, officers or employees (whether in their individual or official capacity and whether current or former employees) is a party, or in which any party is represented by the Department of Justice or the United States Attorney's Office. The United States Attorney requests that the Court extend the January 11, 2019, deadline so that the suspension remains in effect until appropriations funding for the Department of Justice are made available and its furloughed employees return to work.


Absent further Order of this Court, the stay imposed pursuant to Administrative Order No. 82-Supplemental, which suspends, postpones, and holds in abeyance civil matters involving the United States as a party during the government shutdown is extended to February 10, 2019, or until such time as appropriations funding the federal government are made available, whichever occurs earlier.


No party will be required to take any steps in civil litigation affected until expiration of the stay. This Order does not purport to affect rights to or deadlines concerning appeal from any decision of this Court, which will continue to operate and issue orders in the normal course.
