

MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER



The Plaintiff, pursuant to F.R.C.P 65 (b), respectfully moves this Court to issue a temporary restraining order to prevent his execution from taking place. Mr. Workman has filed an action alleging, *inter alia*, that his due process rights will be violated if his execution is allowed to take place before he has had an opportunity to exhaust his remedies in the Inter-American system of human rights. For the reasons set forth in the accompanying memorandum in support, Mr. Workman avers that he will suffer immediate and irreparable harm if he dies before he is able to pursue his remedies before the Inter-American system of human rights.
