## NOTICE REGARDING ELECTION-RELATED PROCEEDINGS ON NOVEMBER 5, 2024

The United States District Court for the Middle District of Tennessee gives notice of the following procedures for emergency election-related proceedings on Tuesday, November 5, 2024. The procedures outlined below are for all Middle District of Tennessee Divisions: Nashville, Columbia, and Northeastern.

## **Election Day Public Access Information**

- 1. The Court prohibits any recording of proceedings. Accordingly, electronic devices, including without limitation, cellular telephones, smartphones, pagers, computers, and tablets are strictly prohibited in the courtroom. *See* Local Rule 83.03.

## **Election Day Court Filings**

- 1. Emergency petitions shall be filed electronically using CM/ECF. If a filer cannot access the CM/ECF system, documents must be filed in hard copy at the Clerk's Office. If after 5:00 p. m., emergency petitions may be submitted for filing by e-mail at <u>operationsmanager@tnmd.uscourts.gov</u>.
- 2. After documents are filed, the attorney must immediately contact the Clerk of Court Lynda Hill at 615-736-2793, or Lynda Hill@tnmd.uscourts.gov, to notify her that a petition/complaint has been filed.
