

ORDER

It is hereby ORDERED that all requests for copies of sealed documents shall be made by filing a motion with the Court in the case in which the sealed information was filed. The assigned judge is best suited to make a determination regarding the release of sealed information. Therefore, to ensure that no information that should remain sealed is inadvertently released, henceforth, the presiding judge will make all such determinations in all cases. The Clerk's Office shall not provide any sealed documents to any person or organization without a court order. The Clerk's Office may, and is directed to, continue to serve sealed orders issued by the Court on the appropriate counsel or parties.
