ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Pursuant to the Criminal Justice Act Plan for the Middle District of Tennessee, the CJA Panel Committee consists of the Chief District Judge, the Federal Public Defender, the CJA Panel Attorney District Representative (PADR), at least one and as many as five criminal defense attorneys who practice regularly in the district who are CJA Panel Members, and an ex officio staff member employed by the Federal Public Defender.


Members of the Committee typically serve a term of three (3) years, and terms are staggered to ensure continuity on the Committee. With the appointment of five members to the Committee, and to ensure Committee members terms can be staggered going forward as contemplated by the Plan, two of the newly appointed members will serve a term of two (2) years.
