ORDER


This Order vacates all previous versions of Administrative Order 95 and is effective on the date of its entry. The previous attorney admission fees set or approved on December 1, 2016, remain in effect except as noted below and are as follows:


- 1.) The enrollment fee for the admission of attorneys to practice before this Court is two hundred thirty-one dollars (\$231.00). One hundred eighty-one dollars (\$181.00) of that amount shall be split with twenty dollars (\$20.00) being credited to the General Fund Receipt Account, Fund 085000 and one hundred-sixty-one dollars (\$161.00) will be credited to the Filing Fee – Judiciary, Fund 510000, which shall be deposited by the Clerk in the Treasury of the United States. The balance of fifty dollars (\$50.00) shall be deposited in the Library and Miscellaneous Fund.
- 2.) The pro hac vice fee of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) per attorney established by Administrative Order 95, dated November 21, 2003, is hereby increased by twenty-five dollars (\$25) to one hundred dollars (\$100.00).


The Library and Miscellaneous Fund is hereby constituted, and shall continue to be governed, as in the past, by a committee of five members composed of the Chief Judge of the District Court, the Chief Judge of the Bankruptcy Court, the Clerk of the District Court, the Sixth Circuit Librarian stationed at the Sixth Circuit satellite library located in the Nashville

Courthouse, and the President of the Nashville Bar Association. The committee shall decide matters by majority vote, with the Chief Judge of the District Court being granted veto power over all matters. Voting in person, by telephone or by email is authorized, and a record of any vote authorizing the expenditure of funds shall be kept by the Clerk. The Clerk of Court shall function as the Secretary of the Library and Miscellaneous Fund and shall be tasked with ensuring all matters are conducted in accord with the provisions of the Guide to Judiciary Policy, Volume 4, Chapter 6, §670 et seq. as it now exists or as updated. In addition, the Clerk shall be responsible for providing committee members with quarterly reports tracking the expenditure of funds and the fund balance.

It is so ORDERED.
