Filing Criminal Sentencing Documents in CM/ECF (effective May 7, 2019)

The Clerk has created three criminal events related to the filing of sentencing documents. They are (1) Position Regarding Presentence Report, (2) Statement Regarding 3553(a) Factors/Sentencing Memorandum, and (3) Other Sentencing Document. (See Figure 1).

Sentencing Events (Figure 1)

Start typing to find an event.

In addition, the Clerk has created a motion relief if the sentencing document(s) must be filed under seal. Please note, you **MUST FIRST** file a Motion for Leave to File Sentencing Document Under Seal in order to file your sealed sentencing document(s). The Motion and Relief are located under Criminal, Motions and Related Filings. (See Figure 2).



When filing a Position Regarding Presentence Report, you are REQUIRED to file a separate Statement Regarding 3553(a) Factors/Sentencing Memorandum. During the docketing process, you will be noticed about this requirement. (See Figure 3).

When filing a Statement Regarding 3553(a) Factors/Sentencing Memorandum, you are REQUIRED to file a separate Position Regarding Presentence Report. During the docketing process, you will be noticed about this requirement. (See Figure 4).

When using the Other Sentencing Document event, you should include a brief description in the text box provided during the docketing process, unless the filing is sealed and disclosure would not be appropriate. (See Figure 5). Do NOT use this event to file a Non-Sealed Motion. You must use the Motion Event and choose the appropriate relief.
