INSTRUCTIONS FOR PAYING FEES ON-LINE WITH A CREDIT CARD

Attorneys have the option of paying certain fees on-line with a credit card. The fees which may be paid on-line are:

- 1. Filing fee for a notice of appeal, subsequent notice of appeal, notice of cross appeal, and notice of interlocutory appeal.
- 2. Fee for admission pro hac vice.

When you are docketing one of the appeal events listed above, you will be prompted to answer a series of questions. If you answer Y to any of the questions, you will not have the option of paying on-line. If you answer N and click <u>Next</u>, you will be taken to the Pay.gov website.

When docketing a motion to appear pro hac vice, you will be prompted to answer whether you are paying on-line with a credit card. If you answer Y, you must enter the number of attorneys seeking admission pro hac vice (maximum is 6) and you will be taken to the Pay.gov website. If you answer N, you will not have the option of paying on-line. Payment should be promptly remitted to the Court by hand-delivery or mail with a copy of the filed motion.

Once you reach the Pay.gov website, it is strongly recommended that you NOT click the <u>Back</u> button on your browser. Pay.gov accepts Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Diner's Club, and Discover. When the initial Pay.gov screen appears, the name and address of the attorney whose login is being used in the CM/ECF system will automatically be imported into the billing address fields. If you are using a firm credit card or one with a different name and/or billing address, you will need to change that information. Select the type of credit card you are using. Enter the credit card number, security code, and expiration date. Then click on <u>Continue with Plastic Card Payment</u> (see figure below).

Regardless of which type of payment you choose, a payment summary screen will appear which allows you to enter an email address where confirmation of the transaction may be sent (see figure below). It is *strongly* recommended that you enter an email address. In order for the transaction to go through, you **must** click on the box next to the sentence "I authorize a charge to my card account for the above amount in accordance with my card issuer agreement." Then click on <u>Submit Payment</u>. Once the transaction is processed, you will be taken back to the CM/ECF site to complete the filing of your document.

Once you are returned to the CM/ECF site, the Pay.gov transaction has been completed and your credit card will be billed regardless of whether you finish filing your document. If for any reason you are unable to complete the filing of the document once the Pay.gov transaction has been completed and you have to start the filing process over, you will be charged a second fee. To have the first credit card charge refunded, the credit card holder must submit a signed letter to the Clerk of Court, United States District Court, 801 Broadway, Room 800, Nashville, TN 37203. You must include the billing address for the credit card, the credit card number, the expiration date, the Agency Tracking ID and Pay.gov Tracking ID from the confirmation email you received as well as the date of the transaction and the name of the attorney whose CM/ECF login and password were used.
